Since 2017, we have maintained our meal prices at \$7.50 per meal, despite rising costs due to inflation, supply chain challenges, and higher operating expenses. Our commitment to making our services accessible to everyone has remained steadfast.

However, to ensure we can continue serving you with the same level of care and quality, we will be implementing a modest meal price adjustment.

What's Changing

- New Meal Prices:
 - Hot Meal \$9.25 (Includes complimentary Soup & Dessert)
 - Frozen Meal \$8.25 (No Soup or Dessert)
 - Sandwich with Soup or Fruit \$4.50

Effective Date: March 1, 2025

This adjustment allows us to recover a portion of the increased cost to prepare and deliver meals, while still keeping prices significantly lower than the actual production cost of \$15 per meal.

Exciting Updates to Our Menu

Starting March 1st, we will be introducing our **new spring/summer menu** featuring seasonal favorites, fresh flavors, and comforting meals that celebrate the warmer months.

We're also thrilled to announce that **fresh baked desserts from our Firehouse Café will be included as part of our meal delivery.** These desserts are made with care by our team and will be a delicious compliment to your meals.
